I understand that my acceptance to the Yardley Harvest Day 2026 event is at the Committee's discretion, and if rejected for any reason, my entry fee will be refunded. I have carefully read and agree to the following guidelines and rules for Yardley Harvest Day 2026.

- **Prior to the day of the event, a current Certificate of Liability Insurance must be submitted.**
- **Displays and canopies must be up and active for the entire duration of the event (10am-5pm).**
No late arrival or early departure.
- **Vendors will be notified of their space assignment and set-up time the week prior to the event.**
- **Once your application is accepted, refunds will not be given due to personal cancellation.**
- **Yardley Harvest Day and associated entities are not liable for personal injury, damage or theft of the exhibitor's display or products.**
- **Pricing of all food items for sale must be clearly posted.**
- **Vendors are responsible for the removal of all trash and debris from their display. Failure to comply may prevent you from acceptance in future events.**

Safety Agreement

I acknowledge that participation in our community, family-friendly event, means safety is a top concern. Therefore, if I am found to be acting in bad conduct or risking event safety, I will be asked to leave immediately and be barred from future events.

Rain Date

The rain date for Yardley Harvest Day 2026 is September 26, 2026. No refunds will be given to participants who cannot make the rain date.

Smoking Policy

There is no smoking at Harvest Day display areas.

Cancellation Policy

The event may be cancelled ONLY if the Yardley Borough Mayor or the Pennsylvania Governor declares an emergency AND the Yardley Harvest Day Committee formally votes to cancel the event. If the event is cancelled, I understand that vendors receive a 90% refund of the fee. Notice of event cancellation will be posted to the Yardley Harvest Day website and social channels.
